
Please join PVSC to walk in the St. Patrick's Day Parade

Come with your Sams this Saturday, March 2 in Old Town Alexandria, VA. Weather is expected to be perfect--overcast, 51 degrees, light and variable winds. No rain or snow predicted. Following are instructions:

- Plan to meet between 11:00 and not later than 11:45 between Queen & Princess Streets on Alfred St. This is the North side of King St. We are in Division 4. Suggest you come early for parking then go for coffee as the side streets will start to be closed off by 9:30 am by the police. Parking garages and public restrooms are indicated on the 2019 Parade route & Staging Maps which can be found on www.ballyshaners.org. Our unit needs to be complete and in position by noon. The pre-parade procession of the Grand Marshal and dignitaries will start at noon, the units in the parade will start moving at 12:30 pm. The parade route extends eastward along King St, from Alfred St, to Lee St, left onto Cameron St, ending between Royal and Pitt Streets.
- Bring water, poop bags, and have your dog on a leash no longer than 6 ft. No Flexi-leads please. Don't forget your camera or phone so you can take photographs.
- Feel free to decorate yourself and your dog in Irish accessories, green, orange, and white. Anyone wearing any sign or emblem that may be considered controversial in nature or not in the spirit and intent of the celebration will be asked to leave. No alcohol, disorderly conduct, or abusive behavior are allowed. No politics please.
- Feel free to bring your scooter or bicycle with your dog in harness.
- Come early to enjoy the classic cars display, the vendors, and enter your dog in the dog show for charity (based on popularity of the fans) before the parade. All are located at Market Square. Details can be found at the Ballyshaners website, www.ballyshaners.org. Would love to see a Samoyed puppy entered into the dog show.

Div. 1 - Military District of Washington—King Street, between Alfred and Patrick Streets

• Enter from Patrick St. onto King Street

Div. 2 - Celtic Division—Alfred Street, between Cameron and Queen Streets

• Enter Queen St. from Columbus Street, turn left onto Alfred Street

Div. 3 – Harp Division—Queen Street, between Alfred and Patrick Streets

• Enter from Patrick Street onto Queen Street

Div. 4 – Rodney Division—Alfred Street, between Queen and Princess Streets

Enter from Princess Street onto Alfred Street

Div. 5 – Emerald Division—Cameron Street, between Alfred and Patrick Streets

• Enter from Patrick St. onto Cameron Street

Div. 6 – Shamrock Division—Alfred Street between King and Prince Streets

• Enter from Prince St. onto Alfred Street
